Best-selling authors' tips on getting published to headline September HRW event

The Barry Robinson Theatre and Fine Arts Center is the site for *An Evening with Lenore Hart and David Poyer* on Friday, September 12. These best-selling authors are residents of Virginia's Eastern Shore and will share their tips for successfully moving through the fiercely competitive publishing world.

Lenore Hart is the author of *Becky—The Life and Loves of Becky Thatcher*, *Waterwoman*, and *Ordinary Springs*.

Her husband, David Poyer, is the author of *The Threat*, *The Anvil of Our Souls: A novel of the Monitor and the Merrimack, Korea Strait*, and other best-sellers.

They have each been featured on the "Writer to Writer" television series on PBS and have been guests on Voice of America. They participate in writing programs at several colleges and universities and are frequent guests at a number of literary festivals.

Advance tickets are \$35 and tickets at the door will be \$45. The event starts at 6:00pm. HRW members attending the event may attend a wine and cheese reception with the couple beginning at 5:30pm.

HRW moves from dream to reality

Lauran Strait, president of the Board of Directors of the Hampton Roads Writers announced in June that the organization had incorporated in the Commonwealth of Virginia as a nonprofit organization and had applied for 501(c)(3) status with the IRS.

"Having 501(c)(3) status will help us in becoming eligible for grant funding from a number of sources," Strait said. Outside funding is essential for the group to fulfill its objectives of creating and supporting literary events and literacy programs in the Hampton Roads area.

"We've had very successful Open Mic events in Virginia Beach and we have Open Mic nights scheduled in Norfolk and Portsmouth for August," Strait added. "We completed a Flash- and Micro-Fiction workshop in July and our *Evening with Lenore Hart and David Poyer* is coming up in September, so we're well on our way to achieving a great first year."

HRW secretary Sherrie Pilkington said, "We have 51 writers in the group at this point and grow at each event, which is wonderful because we have volunteer opportunities available for everybody."

"As more people join us, we'll be able to expand the areas we serve and the programs we offer," Strait concluded.
